

Frequently Asked Questions for OC DSP Golf Tournament

How does the refund policy work?

Full refunds will be available through Sunday, March 1st. After this date, refunds cannot be guaranteed as payments will have been finalized with the venue.

How will payments work?

After reviewing interest form responses, selected participants will receive an official registration invitation beginning February 14th. Payment instructions will be provided at that time and collected through the CSUF Delta Sigma Pi Vemmo or Zelle accounts to secure your spot.

Who is welcomed to the tournament?

The tournament is open to all current members, alumni brothers, and invited guests of Delta Sigma Pi. This event is alumni-centered and designed to create a fun, social, and competitive environment for reconnection and networking.

What is included in the entry fee?

The entry fee includes green fees, golf cart, tournament contest participation, and a catered post-tournament buffet reception provided by Coyote Hills Golf Course.

How will teams be formed?

Participants may register with their own group or individually. Individual registrants will be paired into teams prior to the tournament.

What time should I arrive and what is the schedule for the day?

A detailed event schedule including check-in time, shotgun start, and reception time will be shared once the venue reservation is finalized.

Is there a dress code?

No. There is no required golf attire.

Will food and drinks be available on the course?

Yes. The course features a snack bar and beverage cart where food and drinks may be purchased during play. A catered buffet reception will follow the tournament.

What happens in case of rain?

The tournament will proceed rain or shine unless the course is officially closed by Coyote Hills.

What skill level is this tournament suited for?

All skill levels are welcome. The scramble format is designed to be enjoyable and beginner-friendly.

Where should I park at the course?

Complimentary parking is available directly at Coyote Hills Golf Course.

How do prizes and contests work?

Cash prizes will be awarded to the top three teams with the lowest scores. Contest prizes include Longest Drive (men and women) and Closest to the Pin on a selected par 3.

When is the registration deadline?

Registration invitations will begin February 14th and will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis until the field is full.

Can I rent golf clubs at the course?

Yes. A limited number of rental sets are available through the Coyote Hills pro shop. Please contact them directly in advance to reserve a set.

Will photos be taken and shared after the event?

Yes. Photos will be taken throughout the day and shared with participants following the event.

Is there a limit on players or will the tournament sell out?

Yes. The tournament is limited to 80 players and is expected to fill quickly.
